Our Bible reading today is from a letter
written by Paul a follower of Jesus to the
Christians who lived in Corinth a town in
Greece.

... all of us, have been baptized into the one body by the same Spirit ...For the
body itself is not made of only one part but of many parts. If the foot were to
say, "Because I am not a hand, I don't belong to the body," that would not
keep it from being a part of the body. And if the ear were to say, "Because I
am not an eye, I don't belong to the body," that would not keep it from being
a part of the body. If the whole body were just an eye, how could it hear?
And if it were only an ear, how could it smell?
